#### **Child Death Investigation**

On August 20 2008, at 4:36 p.m., Cincinnati Police responded to the parking lot of Cincinnati Christian University, 2700 Glenway Avenue, for a report of an eleven month old child left inside a vehicle. Upon arrival, officers located a white female, 11 months old, deceased inside a vehicle.

Initial investigation revealed the child's mother, a facility member at Cincinnati Christian University, left the child in her car seat when she reported to work at approximately 8:30 a.m. The child was discovered by her mother as she was leaving work in the afternoon.

The death investigation is ongoing by the Cincinnati Police Department's Criminal Investigation Section, the Hamilton County Prosecutor's Office, and the Hamilton County Coroner's Office.
