



Supplemental Report: on the date and time in question I Sgt Benford was dispatched to 421 E. Green Street, to take a report on incident that happen last night around 4.00am in the morning hours of 06-03-07. The three complaints were at a party at 252 Webb Street, when Odell Thurman and Willie Thurman came up in his black escalade with others and got out and crash the party, Odell Thurman was touching Chad's girlfriend in places he should not have been so Chad told him to stop and one of Odell's friends push him down and Odell kicked him in the face and knocked him out. Then his sister jumped in and got hit and his friend Brett Thomaton got a gun put in his mouth and his hand is bruise real bad and then they left.

Brett Thomaton, I walked outside at the party at 3:00am, and Odell Thurman came up and hit me in the Jaw, then Willie Thurman held me down put a gun in my mouth, and stated he would blow my fucking brains out, I will blow you away it was a chrome gun I don't know what type of gun it was so close in my face then after the incident was over they left.

Amanda Salembier, I was at a party at Britt Thomason's when Odell Thurman and Willie Thurman and others crash the party and push my brother down and kick him in the face. I was sleeping and had no clue what was going on. I woke up to the commotion and found my brother laying there. So I went charging up to Odell and then he hit me in the head and knocked me to the ground. He was with Willie Thurman, they then left and came back a second time and Willie pull a gun and put it in Brett Thomason's

mouth and hit him too. Then they left in Odell's escalade with a girl driving for them.
