**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION 1**

On 10-11-2006, 1400 I responded to [REDACTED] to serve an arrest warrant on the listed subject. I made contact with the subject and advised him the reason we were here and that he was under arrest. The arrest warrant states:

Your affiant is a Detective in the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office Vice Unit, currently assigned to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security as a member of a joint child exploitation task force and a member of the North Florida Internet Crimes Against Children task force. Your affiant has been a member of the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office for over eighteen (18) years and has been assigned to the Organized Crime Section for over eleven (11) years. Prior to being assigned to the Organized Crime Unit your affiant was a Sex Crimes Detective. Your affiant has received formal training in the Sexual Exploitation of Children, Child Pornography and Internet Crimes Against Children.

The suspect was taken to the PMB to be interviewed prior to booking.

.006 at approximately 1:45pm, your affiant went to a residence at [REDACTED] in order to complain regarding the possible exploitation of a child involving video cameras and internet home at [REDACTED] is the residence of Mr. Randall Piercy and Mrs. Michelle Piercy. The [REDACTED] was for sale and the real estate investor who was considering buying the home had initial complaint. Your affiant met with this investor and another real estate broker. This broker, Mr. [REDACTED] is the father of Ms. Piercy and the grandfather of the child at the residence who was identified as the victim. Your affiant entered the residence in an undercover capacity, posing as a possible investor in purchase of the house. Both the complainant and the alleged victim's grandfather knew your affiant's city.

Once inside the home your affiant observed video cameras in virtually every room of the house. A camera was mounted outside of the house to view activity near the entry as well. Your affiant observed a video camera in the upstairs bathroom of the house, positioned in such a manner as to view someone using the toilet. Your affiant observed a door with a dead-bolt type lock installed on the outside of the door, accessible from the hallway. The afore mentioned grandfather unlatched the dead-bolt and opened the door, inside the room your affiant observed a male child, later identified as [REDACTED] was lying on a bed clad only in his underwear, watching television. Your affiant observed a video camera mounted on the wall of the child's room, near the ceiling, and pointed in such a way as to show an image of the child's bed and doorway. The room seemed dirty and smelled faintly of urine. The child seemed very excited to see his grandfather and your affiant and immediately began telling us what he was watching on television (NASCAR) and asked if his grandfather could please come back after showing the house and spend some time with him. The grandfather closed the door and he and your affiant then went to Mr. Piercy's bedroom, next to the room the victim was in. Once in Mr. Piercy's room your affiant observed a large television monitor mounted near Mr. Piercy's bed. The monitor was displaying an image of the child's bedroom and of [REDACTED] on his bed. Also in this room were several computers, all of which appeared to be running. Cables that appeared to be video cables were running into the computers, the cables were coming out of the bedroom wall, apparently running from the other parts of the house.

Your affiant has personally spoken to and taken statements from various family members regarding the child's [REDACTED] treatment by his parents. The information gathered is outlined as follows;

- Mr. Dan Boswell, the child's grandfather, states that he has been told by [REDACTED] mother, Michelle Piercy that [REDACTED] must stay locked in the room unless Randall Piercy allows him out. [REDACTED] is not allowed to go to the bathroom except at specified times, usually once a day, and is expected to "hold it" until the allotted time. [REDACTED] has been punished for going to the bathroom in his bedroom as a result. When confronted regarding this situation Michelle Piercy said that Randall Piercy was teaching the child to "control his body" and that it is a good thing. [REDACTED] is supposed to be being home schooled, however, he cannot read even children's books. Michelle Piercy has stated that she and Randall Piercy do not have the time to dedicate to [REDACTED] schooling that they should and he is "behind". [REDACTED] is only allowed to see Ms. Piercy (his mother) for allotted times set by Randall Piercy, usually one hour a day. Mr. Boswell and his wife are only allowed to see [REDACTED] with Randall Piercy present, never alone. Mr. and Ms. Boswell only see [REDACTED] two (2) to three (3) times per year.
- Ms. Lavenia Boswell, the child's grandmother, confirms the statements made by Mr. Boswell. Ms. Boswell related another story, which her daughter told her. In this account the daughter (Michelle) was apparently outside her son's room [REDACTED] speaking to him. Apparently it was not during one of the times that she was allowed to see him. Michelle and [REDACTED] were speaking and Michelle told [REDACTED] that he was going to get in trouble if Randall (the father) saw him; [REDACTED] replied that he was sitting in an area of the room that the camera could not view, so he was safe to talk to his mother.
- Ms. Heather Drury, Michelle Piercy's daughter by a previous marriage, stated that she used to visit the Piercy residence every other week to see her mother. Ms. Drury is now twenty (20) years old. Ms. Drury stopped visiting when she was sixteen (16) years old because she could not tolerate the way the children were treated at the house. Ms. Drury states that [REDACTED] was always locked up in his room and that before [REDACTED] brothers moved out of the house, there was a area just big enough for [REDACTED] bed that was walled off in a bedroom and [REDACTED] was kept locked in that small area.
- Christina Kasten, Michelle Piercy's sister, states that Michelle allows Randall Piercy to make all the decisions regarding [REDACTED] and that Michelle does not even know what size clothing or shoes [REDACTED] wears or what television shows or games he likes. Ms. Kasten stated that approximately four years ago [REDACTED] was left alone at the Piercy home along with his two brothers who were thirteen and fourteen at the time. She believes it was at this time that [REDACTED].
- Ms. Angela Drury, Michelle Piercy's sister, states that Michelle has told her that she (Michelle) is not allowed to see [REDACTED] except with Randall Piercy's permission, and that she is usually allowed to see him about an hour per day. Ms. Piercy also told Ms. Drury that she was not allowed to come upstairs in the house, where Randall's computers and [REDACTED] room are, unless Randall invites her up. Ms. Drury stated that three years ago, during a conversation with Michelle Piercy, Michelle talked about the fact that she and Randall locked [REDACTED] in his bedroom. Ms. Drury stated that she found this disturbing but did not realize the amount of time that [REDACTED].
